THEATRE YOU CAN FEEL



A thirteen-year-old girl is a wolf. She is fierce, she is blood-spattered, she is hairy.

The dance troupe at the center of Clare Barron's *Dance Nation* is in the midst of an epic metamorphosis. Newly minted teens, the girls (and lone boy, who is an honorary girl) are bursting with hormones but de-

termined to dominate the Boogie Down Grand Prix in Tampa Bay. They have entered that liminal space between the childhood magic of a lucky toy pony and the adulthood magic of using their bodies and minds to shape the world around them. The awkward, embarrassing ordeal of puberty cannot overpower these girls' gnashing fangs and savage spirits.

By setting *Dance Nation* in a middle school-age dance studio, Barron highlights one of the most difficult aspects of growing up: adapting to some pretty extreme physical changes almost overnight. Who is more in touch with their body than a dancer? Suddenly, the girls have less and less control over the physical space they inhabit. They are emotional, confused, frustrated. They might as well have been bitten by a werewolf while they slept.

Still, the 2019 Pulitzer Prize Board described *Dance Nation* (a Pulitzer Finalist) as "a refreshingly unorthodox play that conveys the joy and abandon of dancing." Local Sacramento dancer Kelley Saia is an Artistic Director at Hawkins School of Performing Arts in Folsom. She remembers her own experience growing up: "I was an incredibly shy child with zero interest in any extracurricular activities." But upon enrolling in her first dance class, Kelley found herself becoming more comfortable in her own skin. It was "like I was meant to be there. I loved that I was good at something."


This transformative power that Kelley experienced as a child takes center stage in *Dance Nation*. The indomitable, bawdy, exuberant teens must embrace the innate magic that comes with their changing bodies. They cast their spells through dance and not even puberty can stop them from getting that trophy!

Jacob Gutierrez-Montoya, Choreography






