However, one day she meets Hopkins, who happens to be on the bridge for other reasons. This sparks an unlikely friendship and both Fay and Hopkins begin to heal each other as they process their trauma together. JUMP is a heartfelt new play that tackles the grief of loss and the beauty in connection.

A Note from Our Executive Director & CEO, Lyndsay Burch

In the words of the crowd-favorite Lord Blitheridge, seen in Sarah Groustra's INSERTION: "while I don't normally pull back the drapes on my inner workings," I would like to share with you all a bit about why I chose to present Charly Evon Simpson's JUMP at this point in our 2023 season.

I have been passionate about this piece since I saw it read in Orlando at the National New Play Network's 2018 Showcase of New Plays. My own mental health has been a great focus of my life, as well as the mental health of some of my closest friends, family and colleagues. When I saw this play, I felt it captured these issues in a beautiful, thoughtful and hopeful manner.

Mental health is one of the greatest challenges facing our community and our country at this time. Since the pandemic, I believe we are becoming more aware than ever before that mental health is equally as important as physical health. While this may be difficult or even painful to discuss, the more open we are with our loved ones about these topics, the more we can create a valuable support system and encourage those who may be struggling to seek help.

Although JUMP may not be typical "B Street fare," we thought it wise not to program another comedy after THE PLAY THAT GOES WRONG. Many likely would've said: "that show isn't as funny as the last one" and they would've probably been right. While very different from a classic comedy, I hope you are moved by this piece and the tremendous talent bringing an important story to life.

This play contains some coarse language and deals with themes of grief, depression, and suicidal ideation. We encourage all patrons to use their own discretion in determining the appropriateness of the material.

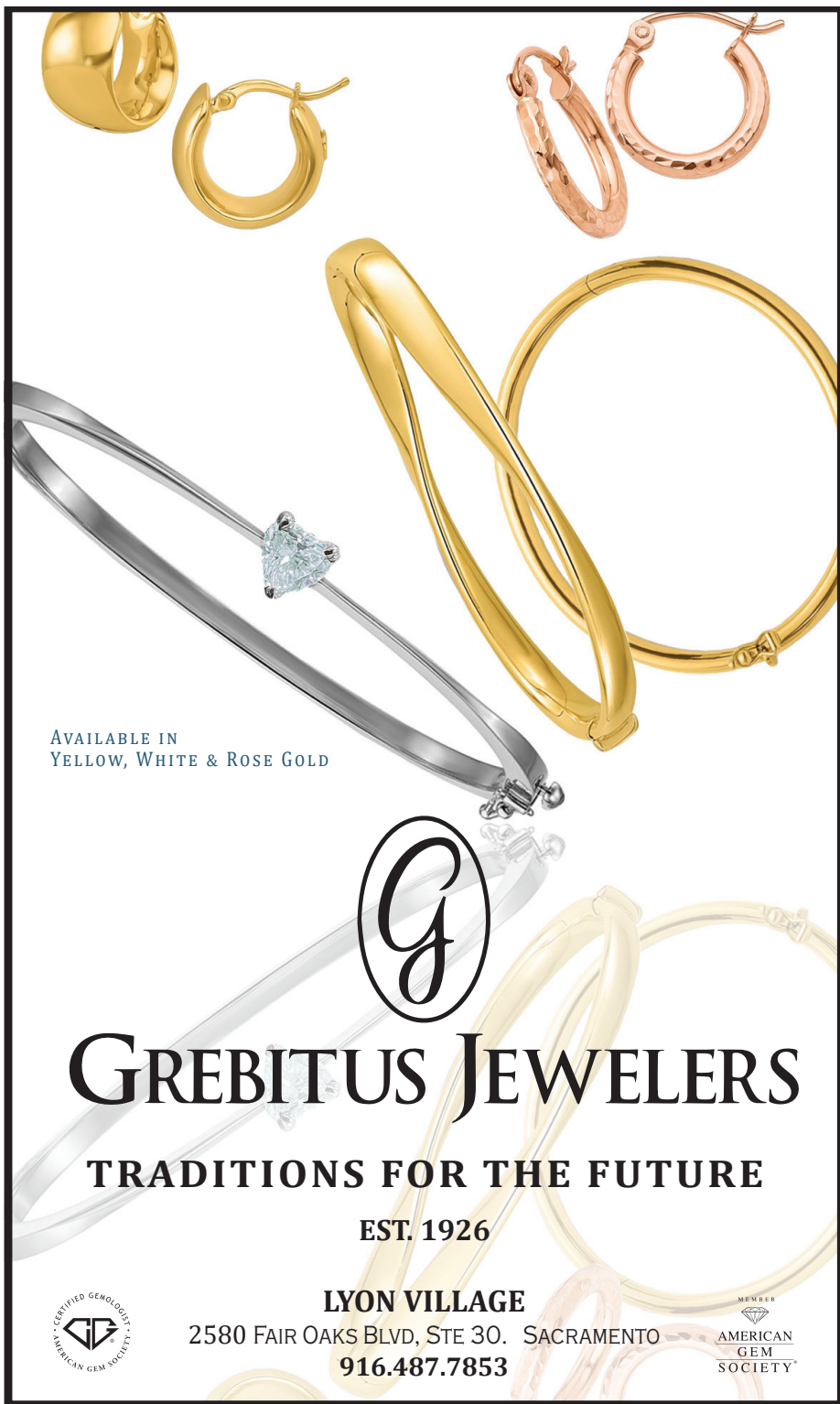
LAND ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Jerry Montoya has worked in professional theater as a playwright, director and producer for the past 30 years. During the pandemic a play about his multi-generational family, NOSOTROS LA GENTE, was commissioned and produced by American Stage in St. Petersburg, Florida as part of their re-imagine series and his play LOVE AND BASEBALL is now a feature film streaming on HBO/Max. For B Street he recently directed BYHALIA, MISSISSIPPI, which closed prematurely due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In the new theater he has helmed HOLMES AND WATSON and THE LEGEND OF GEORGIA MCBRIDE, as well as many others at the old B Street including: A SKULL IN CONNEMARA, RED, THE SEAFARER and he has written 13 plays for the Family Series including MARTIN LUTHER KING AND THE SOUND OF FREEDOM, TREASURE ISLAND, THE FLYING MACHINE, FRANKENSTEIN and his original play about Harriet Tubman, THE CONDUCTOR, has seen two productions at B Street.

Her work has been seen and/or developed with The Eugene O'Neill Theater Center, Vineyard Theatre, WP Theater, Ensemble Studio Theatre, The Lark, Page 73, Ars Nova, Chautauqua Theater Company, PlayMakers Repertory Company, Salt Lake Acting Company, The Fire This Time Festival, National New Play Network through its NNP/Kennedy Center MFA Playwrights Workshop and National Showcase of New Plays, and others. Charly was named the 2019-20 recipient of the Paula Vogel Playwriting Award from the Vineyard Theatre, co-recipient of the Dramatists Guild's Lanford Wilson Award, was nominated for the Outer Critics Circle's John Gassner Award, and had two of her plays on the 2019 Kilroys List. Her play JUMP is the first recipient of the David Goldman Fund for New Plays. She has received commissions from Manhattan Theatre Club/Sloan, EST/Sloan, South Coast Repertory, Barnard College, and more. She's currently a core writer at The Playwrights' Center and a resident of New Dramatists. Charly is a former member of WP Theater's 2018-2020 Theater Lab, SPACE on Ryder Farm's The Working Farm, Clubbed Thumb's 17/18 Early Career Writers' Group, Ensemble Studio Theatre's Youngblood, The Amoralists' Wright Club, and Pipeline Theatre Company's PlayLab.

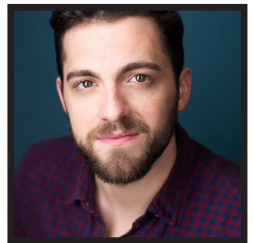
Robert Karma Robinson, **DAD**

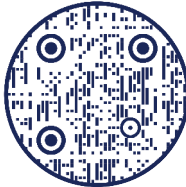

She was honored as one of Sacramento Business Journal's "40 under 40" in 2017 and as one of Sacramento Business Journal's "Women Who Mean Business" in 2021. She is an alum of Elon University's BFA Acting Program, the National Theater Institute, Yale University's Directing Intensive, SDC's Observership Class of 2017 and Theatre Bay Area's ATLAS Program for Directors. Lyndsay serves as the President of the National New Play Network (NNPN). Locally, Lyndsay is a proud member of Point West Rotary (PWR) and she is a recent graduate of Leadership Sacramento, Class of 2020. 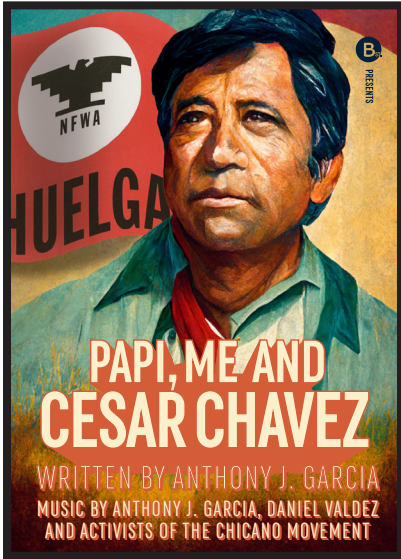
Lori Bluett
